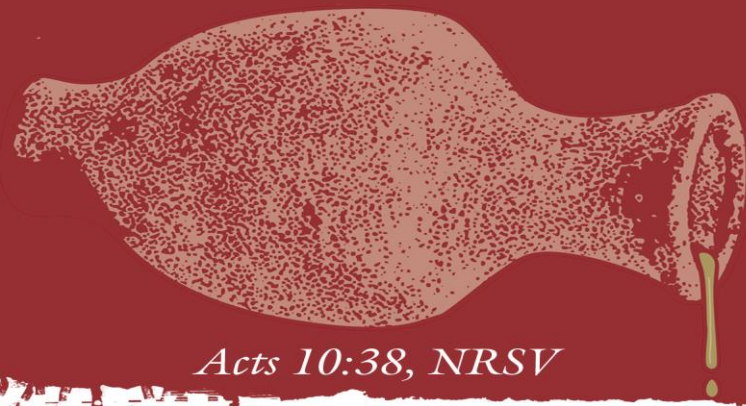

Bible Reading Mark 1:21-28
