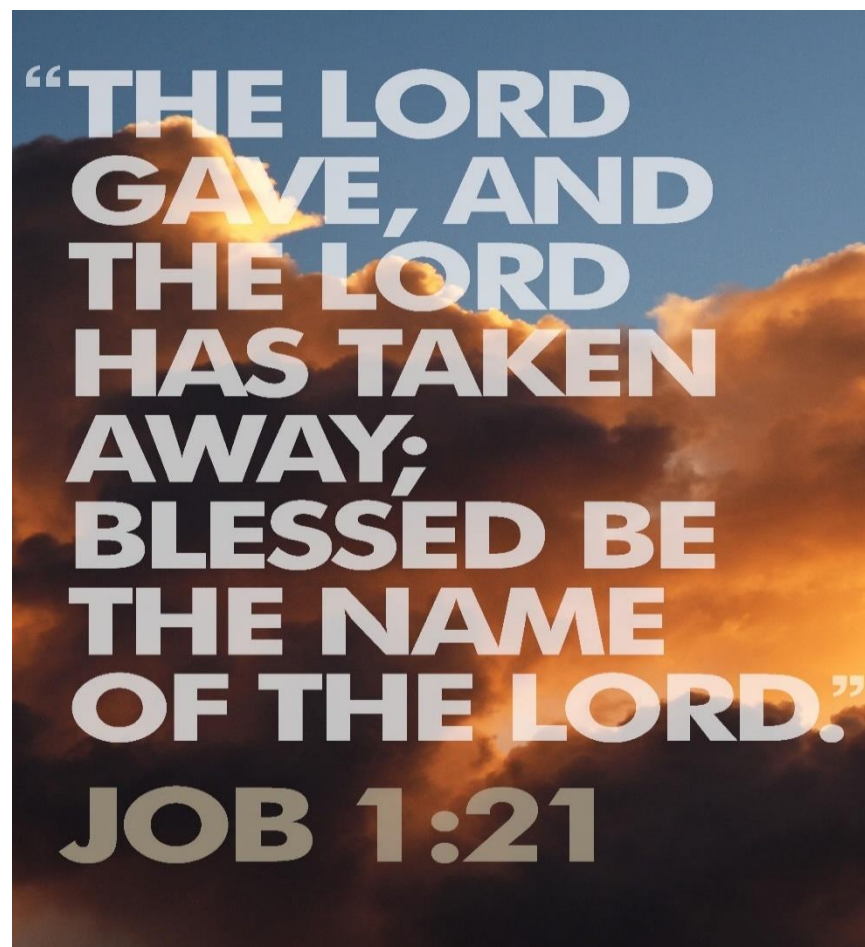

Bible Reading Job 1:1; 2:1-10

2 One day, the members of the heavenly court came again to present themselves before the LORD; and the Accuser, Satan, came with them. ²“Where have you come from?”, the LORD asked Satan.
